



Having an approved and updated plan enables your community to be stronger and more resilient by:

- 3. Building partnerships and relationships with stakeholders within your community and region.

Hazard Miligation Plans must be updated and approved every five years. The LPNNRD last updated their HMP in 2015. This plan update is funded by a FEMA planning grant which includes 75% federal funding and a 25% local funding match. The LPNNRD is providing the 25% local match.






