WHEREAS, a Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared by the Oglala Sioux Tribe and Oglala Lakota County of South Dakota, with assistance from JEO Consulting Group, Inc. of Lincoln, NE.

WHAT IS A HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN?

{Hazard Mitigation Plan = HMP }

HAZARDS
pose **risk** to people, property, the environment, and the economy.

A **Hazard Mitigation Plan** is a community-driven, living document that **assesses vulnerability** to natural and man-made hazards and **identifies mitigation measures** to reduce the vulnerability.

MITIGATION
is any action that **reduces risk**.

WHY SHOULD YOUR COMMUNITY PARTICIPATE IN THE PLAN?

- Gain eligibility for FEMA mitigation grant programs.
- Identifies strategies to reduce your risk to hazards and disasters such as: tornadoes, severe winter storms, flooding, dam failure, wildfire, and thunderstorms.
- Build relationships throughout the region that foster resilience across a larger geographic area.

WHAT TYPES OF MITIGATION PROJECTS ARE IN A HMP?

Oglala Sioux Tribe – For every \$1 spent on hazard mitigation, \$6 in post storm cleanup and rebuilding is saved, according to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Proactive hazard mitigation planning allows a community to take actions to reduce or eliminate threats from natural and man-made disasters. To help guide future hazard mitigation projects, the Oglala Sioux Tribe is undertaking an effort to update their current Hazard Mitigation Plan, last approved by FEMA in 2014. Hazard Mitigation Plans (HMP) are a requirement of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, administered by FEMA, and once a community, county, or district is part of an approved plan, they become eligible for up to a 75% cost share for a wide variety of projects listed in the plan. Hazard mitigation plans are required to be updated on a five-year cycle and the Tribe's HMP will expire in 2019.

A hazard mitigation plan is a publicly-guided document that identifies vulnerability to natural disasters such as flood, drought, earthquake, wildfire, winter storm, tornado/high wind storm, dam failure, etc. The plan sets goals, establishes mitigation alternatives, and prioritizes projects which may alleviate potential damages to property and provide protection when future disasters occur.

This planning effort is being guided by a Planning Team consisting of representatives from the Oglala Sioux Tribe, Oglala Lakota County, and local emergency managers. Public input will be gathered throughout the duration of the plan development through online tools and public meetings.

The Oglala Sioux Tribe has hired JEO Consulting Group, Inc. (JEO) to assist with the plan development over the next 10 to 12 months. This hazard mitigation plan update is funded by a FEMA planning grant. The cost is shared 75% through federal funding and 25% through a local match. For this plan update, the Tribe is providing the 25% local match.

The public is invited to engage in this planning effort by attending reservation district meetings. Work to Update Hazard Mitigation Plan Beginning

PINE RIDGE RESERVATION – For every \$1 spent on hazard mitigation, \$6 in post storm cleanup and rebuilding is saved, according to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Proactive hazard mitigation planning allows a community to take actions to reduce or eliminate threats from natural and man-made disasters.

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A hazard mitigation plan is a publicly-guided document that identifies vulnerability to natural disasters such as flood, drought, earthquake, wildfire, winter storm, tornado/high

OST Emergency Management Plan

PINE RIDGE – The Pine Ridge Indian Reservation is made up of a diverse and sprawling 3,469 square miles of mostly rural terrain. So when an emergency occurs the tribe’s emergency management department needs to be ready for anything.

For more than a decade, the Oglala Sioux Tribe has had an emergency management department in place. That department, however, had fallen by the wayside during past administrations.

With the election of Scott Weston to the OST presidency, and the hiring of a Steve Wilson in October as OST’s Emergency Management Director, the department now has the backing of the President’s office and a leader at the helm.

“The President’s office has been pushing us to get things done,” said Steve Wilson, OST Emergency Management Director. “Things have been pretty busy with the recent cold weather and we had spent most of the day responding to emergencies,” added Wilson.

As the director Wilson’s work should be in the office behind a desk, but with a limited staff and a high number of emergency situations occurring this winter he has spent the majority of his time in the field. On Tuesday (January 3), the tribe had multiple house fires, several residents still trapped from this weekend’s snow storms, and a search and rescue effort that ended after first responders found the body of a tribal citizen who had succumbed to the elements after walking away from a residence on Sunday night.

When the Oglala Sioux Tribal President signs an emergency declaration it allows for resources from all tribal programs to be pooled and utilized under to respond to a situation. The tribe’s Emergency Management department is then responsible for organizing and utilizing those resources in the most effective way possible.

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Additionally Emergency Management is designed to help prevent future disaster situations by helping to develop laws and policies within the tribe. Currently, a large amount of resources are being spent on rescuing tribal citizens who have chosen to place their homes miles off the main road but have no means of navigating hazardous and often snow-blocked roads. Proper zoning laws could help alleviate the pressure on first responders to deal with many of those situations.

"The program is in its infancy but we want to push it in a direction that allows it to start doing what it's supposed to do," added Wilson.

Wilson said that the message the Emergency Management wants people to hear is that weather warnings and road closures must be taken seriously.

"We need people to take the warnings serious and to stay off the roads when they are closed," said Wilson.
